Help protect your family, community, and the environment by safely and properly disposing of them.

- This program is absolutely anonymous. No questions or requests for identification will be made by law enforcement personnel present at the collection.
- Participants should remove any personal information from bottles or packages. Either remove the label or use a permanent black magic marker to strike through identifying information.
- Safely dispose of your unused prescription and over the counter medications without getting out of your car. Drop off will be a drive-through format.
