

SOMERSET COUNTY PROBATION DEPARTMENT OFFERS MINI GRANTS

Somerset County Probation is offering mini-grants up to \$1,000.00 per grant to do service projects that benefit or enhance the community. These grants are the result of profits generated by the Community Service Recycling Program.

The grants are available to any non-profit community group or organization from Somerset County. The projects must address a community need, no matter how small, and must be implemented in Somerset County. Projects need to utilize a community service crew of adults and youths. The projects must have a realistic budget, solid action plan, and a timetable for completion.

It is essential grant applications meet all key elements in order to be considered for funding. These grants are competitive due to limited funds and will be selected by the Community Service Board and approved by the Somerset County Commissioners.

In order to continue these grants, residents of Somerset County are encouraged to drop off their recyclables at one of the following locations: Somerset Wal Mart, Rockwood Community Park, Hidden Valley Maintenance Building, Berlin Municipal Garage, Salisbury Borough Building, Ursina, or Meyersdale. Glass, aluminum, and tin cans are accepted. Recycling containers are available for festivals or any business/organization that would like to join in the recycling effort

Salary or wages.2. Direct donations to other organizations.3. Overhead costs.4. Capital items, such as computers or office equipment.5. Projects must address a community need.2. Projects must be planned and implemented in Somerset County.3. Projects must integrate a community service crew of youth and/or adults.4.
